Lesson 18: We Listen to God and Pray

God speaks to us in the scripture readings and we respond with prayer and petitions. The children will look forward to the reading of scripture at mass, know the responses to the readings and generate some prayers of petition for our class prayer.

Class Discussion:

- We will review the introductory rites we learned about at the last class.
- We will talk about people or things we like to listen to (music, friends, parents, teachers, characters on TV)
- We will talk about the storybooks of our lives photo albums, family pictures
- The Bible and a candle will be placed in our circle in a place of honor. The Bible is God's family album and a collection of family stories for God's family
- We will listen to a sample reading and make a response to it.

Group Prayer:

We will gather around the Bible and hear some short readings. We will then respond with spontaneous prayers of petition.

Ways to Extend the Lesson at Home:

- Make a poster to express your desire to listen to the word of God. Hang the poster near the place you keep your family Bible or where you sit and read it to your children.
- Share your favorite Bible story with your children.
- Let your children act out one of the stories from the Bible. This could include neighbor children of members of your extended family.
- Read the readings for next Sunday with your child. Explain what the readings say to you. After Mass, compare your ideas to those of the priest in the homily.
- Have your child read a few sentences from the Gospels each night as part of your readingtogether time before bed.
