- Have your child read a few sentences from the Gospels each night as part of your reading-together time before bed.
- Take a few minutes before or after Mass to look at the beautiful windows in our church. Tell some of the stories that are pictured there.

## **Teacher Comments:**

This is one of those lessons that will be easy for your child to understand if he/she has a regular experience of mass. We will touch on many scripture passages in this lesson. Ina perfect world your child will have some knowledge of these reading from regular attendance at mass and daily reading of short passages from the Bible at home. It is not too late to begin these practices even if they have not been part of your family's routine. Lent is beginning this week and it is the perfect time to pull out the Bible and read a short passage every day. You do not have to stay with the crucifixion narratives because it is Lent. Read some of the Eucharistic passages or the parables in the gospel of Luke. Jesus was a great storyteller. Let his stories increase the faith of your child.
