- Students tell how he/she helps other members of family/friends.
- Teacher relates some stories in which Jesus helps other people Jesus cures a blind man, a crippled man, a woman with a terrible sore, the soldier's servant, a deaf man.
- Teacher relates some stories of saints who have helped others.
 - St. John Bosco used magic to get children interested in coming to Mass.
 - St. Christopher helped people cross a river
 - St. Vincent de Paul helped the poor.
 - St. Martin of Tours and St. Francis gave clothing to beggars.
 - St. Mary Magdalene helped the apostles in the early days of the Church.
 - St. Elizabeth of Hungary gave food to the poor.

Group Prayer:

Dear God, help me share my love with someone today. (Students are to do some good deed every day.)

- Ask your child to tell you about one of the saints he/she heard about in class.
- Read more about one of the saints in a Book of the Saints or search for information on the internet. Find a list of patron saints for different occupations (especially of parents' occupations) on the internet.
